The Commission has published its final recommendations for new electoral arrangements for Suffolk County Council.

We are proposing that Suffolk should be represented by 70 councillors in future. Our recommendations mean that those councillors should represent one two-councillor division and 68 single-councillor divisions across the county.

The Commission has now completed its review. We are extremely grateful to the people of Suffolk who took the time and effort to send us their views. The Commission considered every piece of evidence it received before finalising these recommendations.


